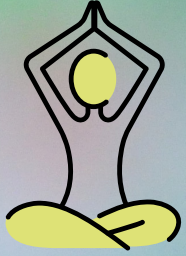

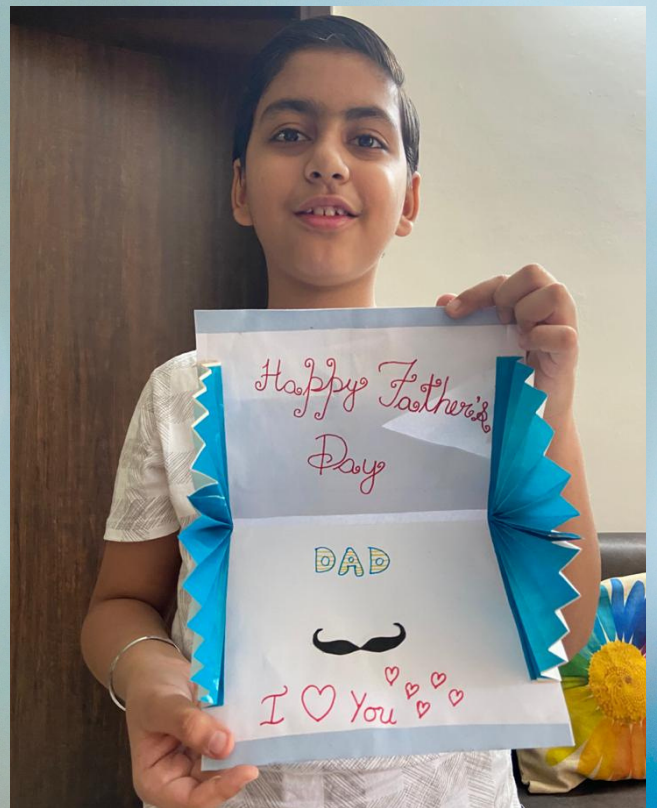


Yoga is a physical, mental and spiritual practice.

CLIMATE ACTION PROJECT



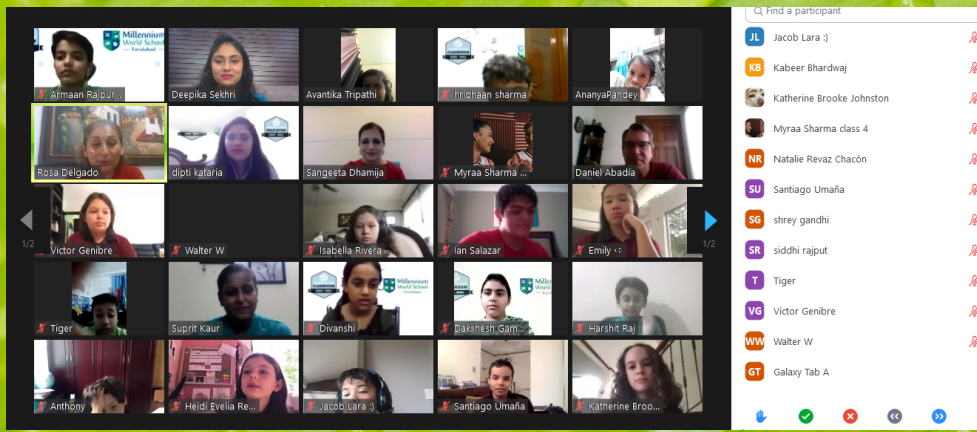
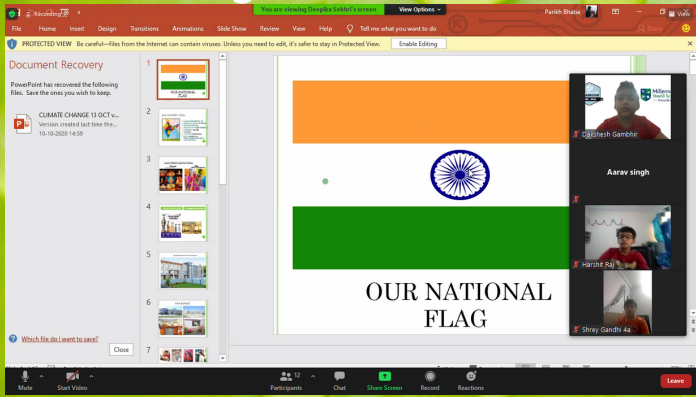
"We have a single mission to protect and hand on the Planet to the next generation."

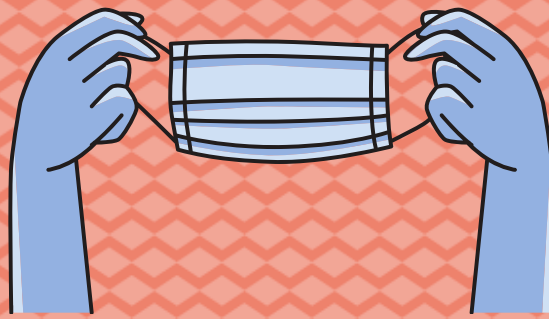


REPUBLIC DAY CELEBRATION
