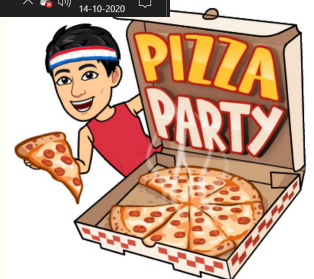


# Microsoft Teams: Our New Classroom!

12th August 2020

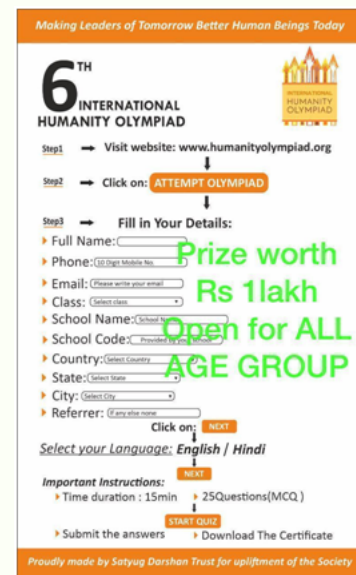
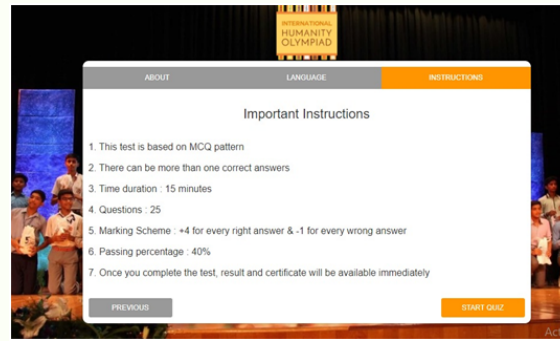

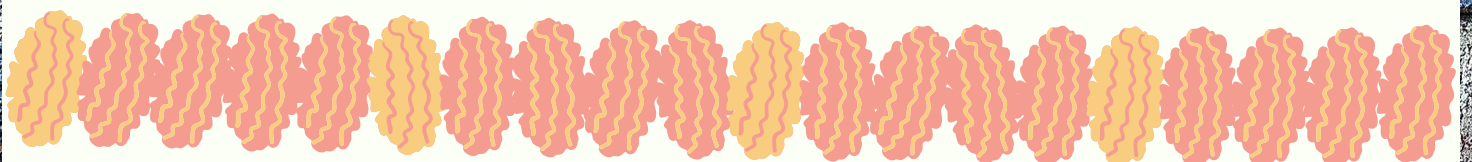
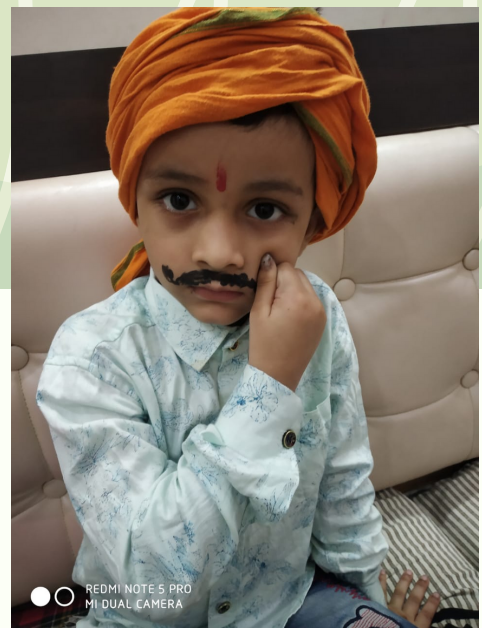
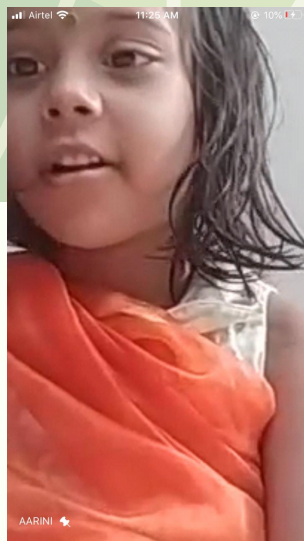
# SPECIAL ASSEMBLY: INDEPENDENCE DAY



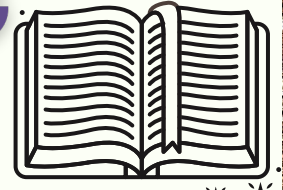
14th August 2020

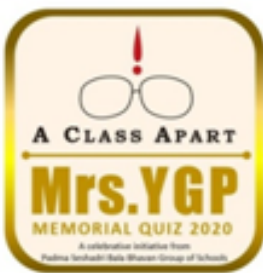


# YGP MEMORIAL QUIZ

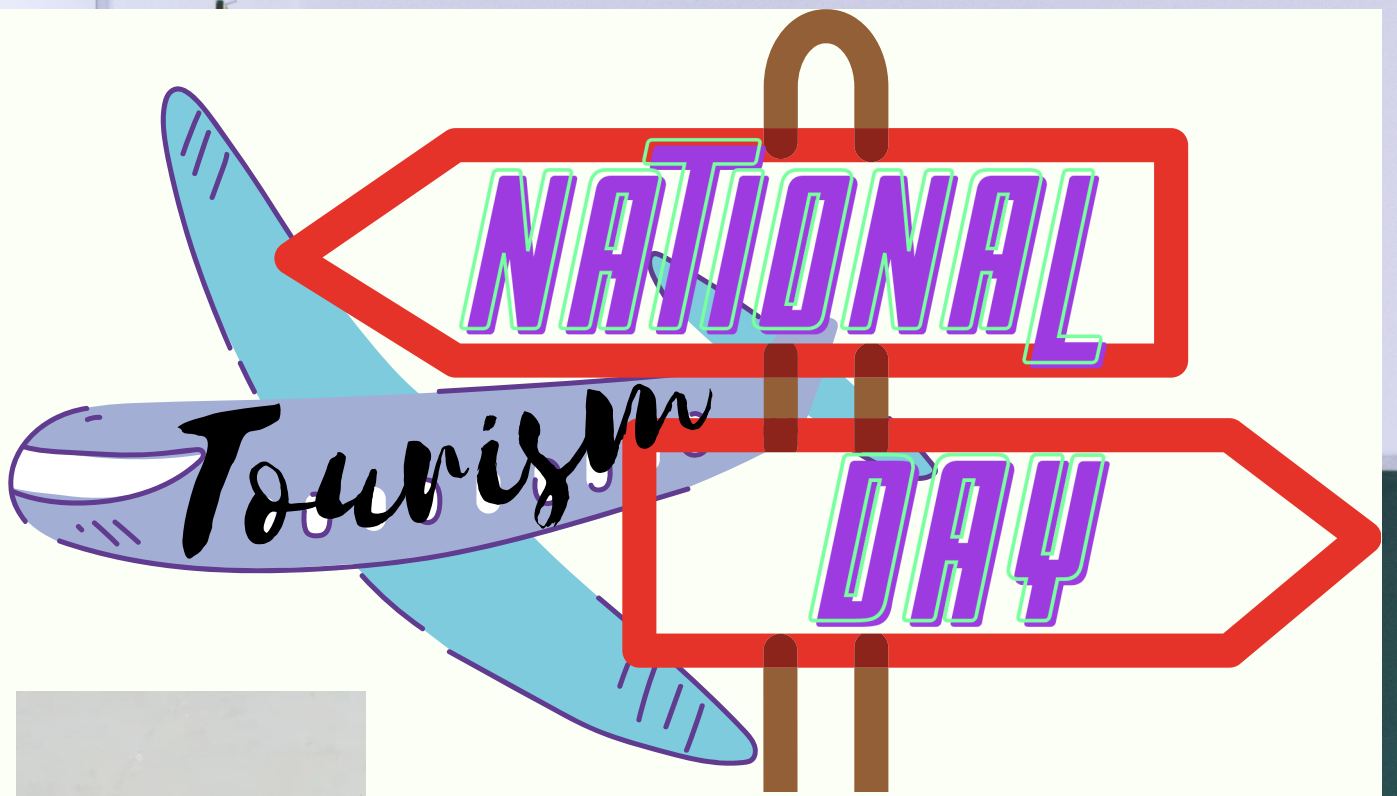
# Mask-up Millennium Campaign



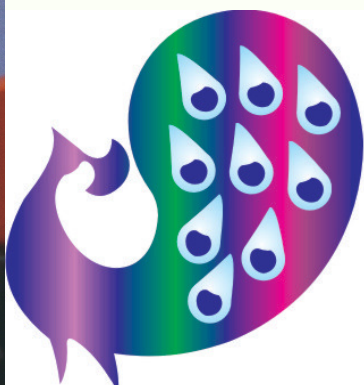

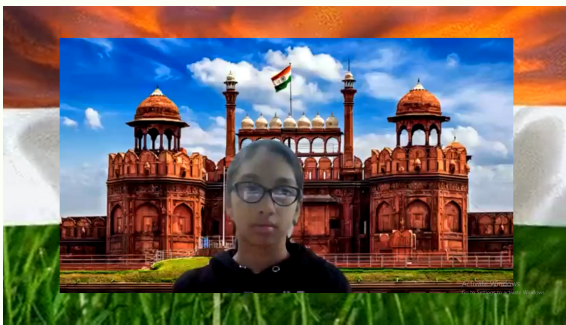

Wheat is the staple food of Madhya Pradesh. Some famous vegetarian dishes include poha and jalebi, bhutte ki khees, and dal bafla.



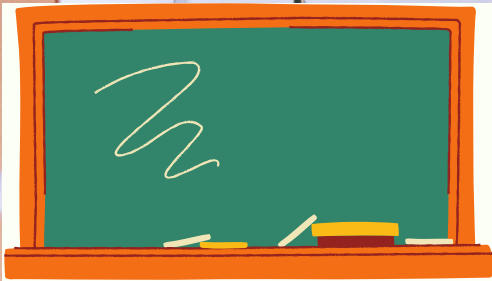
